

RULES AND REGULATIONS  
FOR THE OPERATION OF  
TOWN OF PELHAM, NEW HAMPSHIRE  
TRANSFER/RECYCLING FACILITY

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PUBLIC

1. Users must be resident or seasonal camp owner to obtain sticker.
2. License and registration for vehicle required.
3. Sticker will be affixed to vehicle it was issued to.
4. Only vehicles displaying valid sticker will be allowed use of facility.
5. Only waste generated within the bounds of Pelham will be accepted.
6. Commercial haulers prohibited from use of facility.
7. Recycling and separation is Mandatory.
8. Glass bottles, jars, containers all colors may be mixed. Put on designated table. No metal caps or rings. Plastic caps O.K. Clean and rinsed, please. Also small ceramic and pottery items O.K. with glass. (Zero disposal cost when recycled)
9. Aluminum beverage and tin cans co-mingled clean and rinsed, please. Put in can machine. Metal caps and lids also. (Revenue item when recycled) (Picking of aluminum beverage containers is not allowed)
10. All scrap metal shall be placed in designated area. An effort to remove as much plastic, rubber or wood from metal must be made. All barrels, drums, etc. must have one end cut out or cut in half. (Picking of light iron is not allowed)
11. Aluminum, brass, copper put in designated container. (Revenue item when recycled) (Picking from this container is not allowed)

12. Newspaper, paperback books, computer paper, magazines, junk mail and newspaper inserts as you get them in designated container. (Lower disposal cost when recycled, no plastic bags please)
13. Corrugated Cardboard (no peanuts or foam please) in designated container. (Lower disposal cost when recycled)
14. Clothing, paired shoes, bedding, stuffed animals (clean and bagged) in designated container. (Zero disposal cost to the Town when recycled)
15. Plastic bottles, containers numbers 1-7 clean and rinsed, please. Put in designated container. (No oil containers, no Styrofoam, no plastic toys)
16. Furniture, carpets, bulky items into designated container. (Sleeper sofas must have metal bed frame removed and placed in metal disposal area)
17. No construction or demolition material accepted at this facility.
18. Waste Oil (2 gallon container size limit) (5 gallon containers of waste oil will not be accepted) Mixed oil with antifreeze or gas or water will not be accepted--may be taken to HHW collection in Nashua.
19. Automotive batteries must be placed in designated area (Lead acid only) (This is a revenue item for the Town when recycled)
20. Household batteries - see attendant for information
21. Tires - Limit 4 per week. On the rim accepted. We do not accept loader, tractor, skidder, forklift, solid or foam filled tires.
22. Instructions for LATEX PAINT disposal:  
All paints that can be cleaned up with soap and water are latex. Dried, cracked paint in cans can be disposed of at transfer stations and landfills. NO WET PAINT. For small quantities of paint, add kitty

litter or sawdust to the can and leave open until completely dry. For large quantities, use several sturdy plastic trash bags and alternate paint, kitty litter, sawdust or shredded newspaper and let stand until "crunchy" dry. Seal and dispose of with regular trash. (All other paints, sealers, stains, etc. to HHW collection in Nashua)

23. Non-resident property owners/land or rental property can obtain a temporary permit for clean up of such property by showing a tax bill for property in applicants name.
24. Picking only by written permission from Transfer Station Superintendent or Board of Selectmen.

LIMITED AND PROHIBITED MATERIALS

The following materials are prohibited or otherwise limited at the Facility:

1. Automotive gas tanks must be empty and cut in half. All metal fuel containers must be cut in half--gas cans etc.
2. Propane tanks (See attendant).
3. Acetylene, Oxygen or any welding type tanks not accepted. Some welding supply companies will accept these tanks and recycle them.
4. Junk cars or large automotive parts not accepted.
5. Construction/Demolition material not accepted. C & D can be brought to Lowell Road Wood Processing in Salem, N.H. 898-4089 for a fee. Also containers can be rented from your local trash hauler for disposal.
6. Asbestos not accepted (Federal and State regulated) must be brought to licensed asbestos landfill. For information, call Nashua Solid Waste Division 594-3329.


7. Brush - Brush only--no mixed loads--nothing over 5" in diameter. No stumps or other wood accepted. No leaves or grass accepted. (State Law)
8. Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers, water coolers or any freon containing appliance: A \$10 fee will be required for disposal. Any unit listed above without a compressor must pay a \$10 fee also, as all units must be certified by a licensed contractor. (Federal law)
9. Hazardous wastes not accepted at the Pelham Transfer facility. Hazardous waste collection in Nashua: (See attendant for dates, list of materials and directions)
10. Industrial/commercial waste not accepted--a product/waste/residual generated in excess of a normal household or a product/waste/residual generated outside the boundaries of Pelham. Such prohibited wastes include but are not limited to the following:
  - a. A by-product of an industrial or commercial business.
  - b. A product/waste/residual in excess of what would be considered normal for a single household.
  - c. A product/waste/residual when brought to the facility which could place an added burden on the budget due to the excessive quantity of it.
  - d. A product/waste/residual which is generated outside the boundaries of Pelham.
  - e. A product/waste/residual which is detrimental to the environment or determined by the Facility staff to be detrimental to the Facility equipment.

f. Issues raised about any of the above may be appealed first to the Town Administrator and then to the Board of Selectmen.

Changes in environmental regulations are constantly being put into effect by Federal and State agencies. Questions should be directed to the Transfer Facility at 635-3964.

#### ADOPTION

The Town of Pelham Board of Selectmen hereby rescind all former rules and regulations regarding the Town Solid Waste Facility and hereby adopt Policy # 02-02, Rules And Regulations For The Operation Of Town Of Pelham, New Hampshire Transfer/Recycling Facility.

#### POLICY

It is the goal and intent of the Town of Pelham to provide appropriate waste disposal service to the community in an efficient and environmentally safe manner. The Town operates a Transfer/Recycling Facility for this purpose. This policy outlines the rules and regulations for the operation of that facility.

#### HOURS OF OPERATION

Tuesday 10:30am to 7pm (The public will not be admitted after 6:55 p.m.)  
Wednesday - Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (No admittance after 4:25 p.m.)
