Mr. Abdifar,

I have been receiving several complaints from citizens who are not being given the thirty-day (30) notice prior to survey crews arriving on their property.

Per RSA 371:2-a, it states,

"A public utility desiring to enter land in pursuance of this section shall notify by certified mail the owner or probable owner or owners thereof of its desire to enter for the purposes aforesaid at least 30 days prior to entry. Notification shall include identification of the utility seeking to enter the land, the time and date of the proposed entry, and the portion or section of land to be surveyed or investigated. Upon the date specified for entry, the persons conducting the survey or investigation shall present themselves to the property owner and show identification. The public utility shall pay the owner or owners of any land it shall enter in pursuance of the provisions of this section for any actual damage done upon entry".

If you could review this statute with your survey personnel and ensure that said personnel are complying with this statute I would greatly appreciate it.
