

## 2nd Alarm Building Fire 86 Nashua Road 11/02/2009

On Monday November 2, 2009 at 2320 the Pelham Fire Department was dispatched to the area of Nashua Road and Brookview Drive for a reported Building Fire. First arriving crews reported a residential new construction building with heavy smoke showing from the second floor. A Working Fire was requested and crews went to work. Upon entering crews found fire conditions in the first floor/garage ceiling area; initial attack of the fire was made from the garage due to the location and burn through of the first floor structure. Crews were able to extinguish the fire quickly but extensive overhaul was needed to extinguish multiple hot spots located within the framing of the floor. The house sustained extensive smoke and heat damage throughout the house. The fire went to 2 Alarms and assistance was received from Windham, Londonderry, Hudson, Salem NH, Methuen and Dracut, MA. The cause of the fire is currently under investigation by the fire department.
