Tot Camp is open to Pelham residents only and will run rain or shine on Tuesdays and Thursdays from July 7 through August 13, 2026. Camp Hours are 10:00a.m. to 2:0

0p.m. Campers will receive camp T-shirts on the first day. A weekly activity calendar will be shared and may be adjusted due to weather or special circumstances.

Tot Campers Check List

- Lunch, snacks and plenty of fluids
- Sunscreen applied before arrival (extras available for re-application)
- Bug spray recommended
- Comfortable clothing for outdoor play.
- Labeled paint T-shirt or smock labeled with your child's name (to remain at camp)
- Labeled bathing suit and towel daily (water play activities)
- Written permission required for alternate pick-up
- We strongly recommend labeling all belongings, as children may not always recognize their own items
- **Requirement:** Children must be fully potty trained to participate in Tot Summer Camp.

Food and Allergy Notice:

- We will have a separate peanut-free table at camp. Please note no microwave is available, we kindly ask that any snacks sent to camp be peanut-and tree nut-free to help keep all campers safe.

Arrival and Departure Procedures

Morning drop off and afternoon pick up will take place through a carpool line. When arriving at the lodge, please stay to the left, travel down the dirt road, and loop around to the paved area in front of the lodge to form two lines. Staff will be there to guide you. During morning drop off a counselor will come to your vehicle assist your camper out of the car and walk them safely into camp.

On the first day of camp, each parent/guardian will receive a folder labeled with their camper's name. This folder must be displayed on your dashboard or held up to your window during afternoon pick up to help staff quickly identify each camper and keep dismissal running smoothly.

A counselor will escort your camper to the vehicle; however, staff are not responsible for buckling children into car seats, boosters or seat belts.

This system is in place to ensure a safe and efficient drop-off and pick-up process each day. No child will be released to an unknown or unauthorized individual

This summer will feature weekly themes, hands-on activities, music and movement, science, storytelling, outdoor fun, and special guests-all in a warm, supportive setting. We are also excited to welcome teen Counselors-in-Training who will assist our campers throughout the season.
