General comments and observations

1 "

Seasonal flowers for impact i.e. 600 8" mums throughout town properties will be installed with 5/10/10 fertilizer, watered and cared for throughout the seasonal growing periods.

Over seeding rate of 4/5 lbs. per 1000 sf should be done at the time of fertilization to capture the effects of the fertilizer.

Low areas are noticeable, in the soccer fields at Muldoon Park. I recommend filling these sunken areas, seeding this spring before someone twists an ankle.

Newcomb Field is in tough shape. The field needs grading and topdressing with loam. The whole outfield should be re-seeded especially if field is to be used for play. Also viewing area around benches should be filled in since erosion is evident.

Poison Ivy/sumac evident along walls at entrance to Muldoon and walls at Veterans by tennis courts, behind buildings and other areas where children play. There are numerous sinkholes on playing field at Veterans, which theses low areas are dangerous. Recommend poison ivy/sumac spray and fill holes and seed in playing field.

Fire station grounds lack curb appeal. Areas need to be re-loamed, seeded, and watered.
