The Pelham, NH Transfer Station is requesting proposals for the following Services:

1. Provide 100 yd. closed container that is compatible with our compactor for the purpose of hauling MSW.
2. Provide 2 compactor units with 40 yd. closed roll-off containers for the purpose of hauling plastics Nos. 1-7 and OCC (Old Corrugated Cardboard).
3. Provide 1 – 20 yd. closed top with windows for collecting newspaper.
4. Provide 2 – 30 yd. open top roll-offs for collecting tin cans and assorted materials that we have labeled Junk.
5. Provide 1 – 20 yd. open top on an on-call basis for hauling ash from our brush burn pile.

Provide a list of charges for the following:

1. Container rental fees.
2. Compactor rental fees.
3. Tipping fees for the following:

Ash from Brush burn pile. Material classified as Junk. MSW tipping fee 2,800-3,000 tons generated per year.

Any associated fees for disposal of recyclables – Newspaper – OCC – Plastic Nos. 1-7, - Tin Cans.

Hauling fees for 100 yd. MSW trailer, 20 yd. Ash Container, 30 yd. Tin Cans, 30 yd. Junk, 40 yd. compactor Plastics Nos. 1-7, 40 yd. compactor for OCC, 20 yd. Newspaper Container

Any related fuel surcharges.

Any increases from year to year on equipment, hauling and tipping.

Revenues to be provided for Tin, Plastics, OCC and Newspaper. Please reference published benchmark and terms for recycled materials prices paid to the Town.

Proposals will be accepted for a 3 year term and a 5 year term.

Participants may also provide bid alternatives based on estimated Facility tonnage with the intent of proposing a more efficient process for said tonnage. Estimated tonnage is as follows:

Ash – 28 tons	OCC – 142 tons	Newspaper – 288 tons
Tin cans – 27 tons	Junk – 130 tons	Plastic – 48 tons
MSW – 2,808 tons		

Proposals will be listed separately.

Deadline for submission of proposals will be **Tuesday, September 15, 2009 @ 4PM EST.**
