

General Requirements/Notes:

- The Town is seeking a single turnkey bid for a period of three (3) years April 1st, 2007 to November 30, 2009. All vendors need to be specific in identifying the cost for each year of the contract as the Town operates on an annual budget.
- Vendor shall supply all necessary equipment and materials to perform the proper grounds keeping in all aspects of this contract.
- **A list of equipment shall be furnished**
- Vendor shall **include preliminary insurance certificate** showing that workers compensation, public liability, property damage, related licensing i.e. chemical is secured. The vendor shall require the subcontractor(s) similarly to provide like insurance letter for employees to be engaged in such work. *The adequacy of protection shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Selectman.*
- Vendor shall supply the Town Administrator and Building Maintenance Supervisor with MSDS sheets prior to fertilization program.
- Interested bidders will be invited to conduct a site walk of all areas prior to submitting.
- All proposals shall include a detailed listing of Vendors prior experience and at least three references.
- Special attention must be given to monuments in public areas prior to holidays. Areas need to be groomed and presented i.e. shrubs trimmed, mulch freshened, etc.

The evaluation process will include each bid being reviewed by the Town Administrator, Building Maintenance Supervisor, and Recreation Director. The final recommendations will be submitted to the Board of Selectman for their approval.

The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids, either in whole or part: to waive any defects, informalities and/or irregularities in bid response; to accept substitutions or exceptions to these requirements; to negotiate with the successful vendor; and to otherwise act as shall be determined by the Board of Selectmen to be in the best interest of the Town.

If any additional areas are to be added to the site list during this contract period the Town Administrator, Building Maintenance Supervisor or Parks and Recreation Director reserves the right to negotiate any additional charge with the contractor.

Vendors' bids will be evaluated against specifications as presented in this document. No award will be made to any vendor who can not satisfy the Board of Selectmen that they have sufficient ability and experience in this class work and sufficient capital and plan to enable them to prosecute and complete delivery of the services successfully within the time frame defined herein. The Board's decision or judgment on these matters shall be final, conclusive, and binding.

Lawn and General Maintenance

A. Lawn and grounds clean-up

- Spring-During the month of April all trash, dead thatch, leaves, and other debris will be removed from lawn areas, and mulch beds. (Sooner weather permitting).
- Fall-During the months of October/November leaves and fallen debris will be removed from mulch beds and lawn areas.
- Removal of fallen trees and branches caused from winter damage. Repair lawns from snow plow damage, which includes rakes, loaming, and seed.
- On going general site clean up.

*Note 1. does not include sand removal from parking lots.

B. Lawn mowing and maintenance

- Trash pick-up (intended to mean litter on the grounds) shall be performed prior to all cuttings.
- **Sports fields at all schools including Harris Complex** are to be kept in an acceptable condition, not to be allowed to grow longer than three inches (3"). The schedule cuttings of the sports fields shall be coordinated with the Athletic Directors at High School and Memorial School due to the need of the vendor to prepare and/or repair the fields for practices and games. Trimming of fence lines, around mulch areas, buildings, any and all obstacles as necessary to present a clean site.
- Athletic Fields- Baseball, Softball, Soccer, Field hockey, Lacrosse, Football - Proper maintenance of all playing fields in accordance to industry specifications. To include, but not limited to stripping of fields, hatch marks, correct/acceptable turf heights at infield/outfield, proper height of pitching mound, correct widths and length of base paths, etc.
- All non-grassed infields areas shall be edged and dragged on a weekly basis and kept weed free.
- Hand weed to control weed growth, in mulch beds as needed.
- The vendor shall be responsible for ensuring that all areas are maintained as specified in this contract (i.e no longer than 3" or 4"), and there shall be no predetermined number cuttings. The vendor is responsible to monitor the turf areas and ensure that the grass does not exceed the height specified.
- Clippings are to be bagged if needed as not to impede play on fields or unsightly grounds.
- Walkways, doorways shall be cleaned after all cuttings.

- **Town properties and recreational fields** are to be kept in acceptable condition, not to be allowed to grow longer than four inches (4"). The scheduled cuttings of the park areas shall be as follows:
 Muldoon- once per week May 1st through October 31st, no weekends.
 PVMP playing field- once per week June 1st through September 30th.
 PVMP building areas- once per week June 1st through September 30th.
 PVMP monument- once per week May 1st through October 31st.
 Lyons- once per week May 1st through June 30th.
 Lyons- every other week July 1st through August 31st.
 Lyons- once per week September 1st through October 31st.
 Newcomb Field- once per week May 1st through September 30th.
 Raymond building area- once per week May 1st through October 31st.
 Raymond soccer field- once per week May 1st through September 30th.
 Raymond new fields- bid separate for 2008 and 2009
 All PVMP cutting should be completed before 9 am. All schedules are to be coordinated with Park and Rec. Director due to various activities.
 Trimming of fence lines, around mulch areas, buildings, any and all obstacles as necessary to present a clean site.
- Hand weed to control weed growth, in mulch beds as needed.
- The vendor shall be responsible for ensuring that all areas are maintained as specified in this contract (i.e no longer than 3" or 4"), and there shall be no predetermined number cuttings. The vendor is responsible to monitor the turf areas and ensure that the grass does not exceed the height specified.
- Clippings are to be bagged if needed as not to impede play on fields or unsightly grounds.
- Walkways, doorways shall be cleaned after all cuttings.
- De-thatching shall be performed on all fields as the need arises and as directed by the Town. The vendor shall specify the unit price per square foot for the activity as a separate item and not included in lump sum prices.
- Overseeding shall be performed on all fields as the need arises and as directed by the Town. The vendor shall specify the unit price per square foot for the activity as a separate item and not included in lump sum prices.
- Sod shall be replaced in high wear areas of all sites as the need arises and as directed by the Town. The vendor shall specify the unit price per square foot for the activity as a separate item and not included in lump sum prices.

C. Fertilization

- Vendor shall use granular fertilizer for all rounds of treatment versus liquid products. Liquid products may be used for spot treatment.
- Vendor shall notify the appropriate personnel two days prior to fertilization taking place at said locations.

- Vendor shall be licensed with the State of New Hampshire to apply pesticides and herbicides. MSDS sheets shall be provided on all products.
- All areas shall be fertilized. Vendors shall recommend a program based on their finding. A cost per unit shall be presented for each application. The Town Administrator, Building Maintenance Supervisor, and Parks and Recreation Director has the option to choose appropriate applications. Not to be included in lump sum price.
- A separate lime item cost shall be added based on recommendations of vendor for fertilization program to the total bid package.

D. Shrubs, bedding and tree maintenance

- Complete edging of all plant and mulch beds to established contours. Ongoing to be completed by end of May. Smooth and properly install Hemlock mulch installed during spring clean up.
- Prune all shrubs and trees (under 20') twice per a season and or as needed to maintain shapes.
- During the month of May seasoned flowers shall be planted (for impact) and maintained throughout the growing season at the following locations.
 - Village Green – except Historical Society, Town Hall Annex
 - Recreational Facilities – except Raymond Park
 - Schools
- Repeat fall seasonal flowers during the months of September and October at said locations.
- Hand weed, spray and/or application of preen to control weeds during spring spruce up of planting areas.

E. Irrigation

- Vendor shall supply all necessary equipment to perform proper maintenance of all irrigation systems in place. (School complex, Harris Field only, Village Green)
- Vendor shall perform on going checks of sprinkler systems in all zones by running a test cycle. All control boxes should be clear of all foreign materials. Any problems and/or defects shall be reported to the Building Maintenance Supervisor for resolution.
- All systems shall be blown out at the end of the season and prepared for winter.
- All repairs to irrigation systems shall be done on a cost plus percentage basis for materials. The vendor shall provide the labor rate based on work required.

Q&A's

2007 Lawn Maintenance RFP

Question: Can Muldoon be mowed on Sundays?

Answer: Yes, just check the little league and razorback schedules on line before doing so. The town would prefer it being mowed during the week however. No mowing before 8 am.

Question: When can Muldoon be mowed during the day/week?

Answer: It is best to mow Muldoon week days starting at 8 am and finishing by noon. This will only change during soccer camp weeks June 25-June 29 and August 20-24. Please review the little league schedule and/or razorback schedule on line to confirm on a weekly basis during their seasons.

Question: Are there specifics regarding the repairs near the portables?

Answer: No, the repairs will be bid out separately at a later date by the school department. The general bid should not include the repairs because we do not have the specifics at this time.

Question: What town fields need to be edged in the spring?

Answer: The following baseball/softball fields need edging: Senior League (Muldoon); Major League (Muldoon); Softball (Muldoon); Minor League (Muldoon); Lyons Softball (Lyons Park); Newcomb Softball (Golden Brook Park/Newcomb Field). The edging should be included in the bid.

School sports schedules are posted to plan out field striping schedules at the schools. Do not bid striping at the Town fields of Muldoon, Raymond, Lyons and/or Newcomb as the Town will stripe these fields. Only bid the striping at the school sports fields.

Question: How many fall sports games are at the high/middle school?

Answer: The schedule is not available at this time but the field will need to be mowed and lined for the following: 13 Soccer games, 7 field hockey games, 8 football games.

Question: When will I know if I won the bid?

Answer: A committee of various town organizations will be presenting the Board of Selectmen and the School Board their recommendation on March 20th. 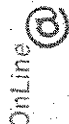
