The site walk began at 1:00 p.m. Members and the applicant's representatives observed the location of the proposed building, the elevations and location of the flood plain, WCD and finger of wetland. The parking lot entrance and exit were clearly visible as they will be in the same location as when the gas station occupied the lot. Members questioned the size of the parking lot. The required spaces for this size building is 14 spaces. Mr. Maynard is asking for a waiver for 12 parking spaces. This seems like not enough parking for this type of business. There must be parking for 2 cars for each client as there will be the client and the hair dresser. Parking could run out easily as clients arrive early for appointments and other clients are still inside the building. Parking was the biggest concern for the members. Members do not want a case where parking is waived to 12 spaces, then the business does not have enough spaces and they want more spaces added to the lot, which may impact the WCD further.

No vote was taken at the site walk. The applicant has been invited to the January 2024 meeting.
