Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M.

Trail Adopter Report

Merriam Cutter – tree removed from trail; trash removed from parking area; mowing underway around sign; trees trimmed around parking area; more brush to be removed to provide greater visibility in parking area

Snowmobile Trail Report – trail work for fall being planned

<u>Moeckel Road Town Forest</u> – timber harvest underway; landing is being created on Moeckel Road per management plan; 3 abutters attended meeting to express concerns. The following was discussed:

- 1. Approximately 42 feet of stone wall on town-owned land was pushed to the side to create a short access road and landing for a timber harvest on Moeckel Road Town Forest; a feller buncher was used to enter the property to work on clearing the access road and landing; the feller buncher breached the stone wall by driving over the stone wall; stones from the wall were preserved and are being stored to the left of the entrance
- 2. Prior to the start of the forestry job, loggers were instructed by Town Forester to set aside stone wall boulders for potential future use

- 3. Landing area was stumped and surface soil scraped into temporary piles to prevent muddy conditions during timber harvest
- 4. Landing size and location was pre-determined by Town Forester to accommodate site conditions including roadway site distance, turning radius and possible avoidance of wetland impact
- 5. Trees cut from landing were stacked to the back and sides of newly created landing per standard practice
- 6. Town Forester sent abutters notice letter on 5/29/2019
- 7. After harvest, Forestry Committee will repair stone wall and seed landing if Town Forester recommends; work to be done when practicable
- 8. Going forward, Forestry Committee will provide a link to the forest management plan posted to town website in notice letter; provide a landing buffer if possible; minimize stone wall disturbance without impeding forestry work and repair if feasible

Discussion of 2020 Warrant Articles

Review of budget, remaining funds and amount in Forest Maintenance Fund; vote to eliminate warrant article for 2020; In favor – Brendan Decelles, Bob Lamoureux, Gayle Plouffe, Deborah Waters; Opposed – Paul Gagnon; Passed 4 to 1
