Rules for Kayaks and Stand-Up Paddleboards—MUST HAVE VALID BEACH PASS

- Kayaks and Stand-Up Paddleboats are for use of Pelham Residents and their guests.
- Kayaks and Paddleboards may be signed out for one-hour periods of time.
- Kayaks and Paddleboats must be used only within the designated areas. The user must Always remain in full view of the lifeguard and staff. Failure to do this will result in loss of use.
- Life jackets provided ***must*** be always worn by children and adults.
- The Waterfront Director or lifeguards may revoke privileges of anyone misusing equipment, disobeying rules or otherwise acting in an unsafe manner.
- The user is responsible for all equipment signed out and may be subject to a fee to replace broken equipment.

Rules for Specific Watercraft (Kayaks)

- Persons signing out kayak must be 18 or older.
- Children over the age of 10 may be in separate, single person kayaks accompanied by parent/guardian. If child is under 10, they must be in same kayak as parent.

Stand Up Paddleboard

- Persons signing out Paddleboards must be 18 or older.
- Anyone under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older.
