In accordance with the Pelham Police Department Rules of Conduct General Order, please read the following excerpt below pertaining to "Personal Appearance" and your name in the designated area as acknowledgement of the General Order.

***Personal/Professional Appearance:*** In order to ensure professional appearance and personal safety, all employees, whether in uniform or civilian attire, shall be neatly dressed and groomed in accordance with contemporary conservative standards as determined by the Chief of Police. Personnel will maintain a neat, clean appearance on duty. They will keep their uniforms clean, pressed, and in good condition. They will keep their hair neat, clean, and cut in a prescribed manner. With the exception of mustaches worn in the prescribed manner, officers will keep themselves cleanly shaven. Poor grooming or improper wearing of the uniforms or its accessories will be grounds for disciplinary action. The Chief of Police may authorize the wearing of beards to those officers suffering from the condition known as pseudofolliculitis barbae. Rings shall be limited to one per hand. Bracelets and visible necklaces shall not be worn, with the exception of medical alert bracelets. Female officers may wear post earrings of either small stud or stones for pierced ears, one per ear. Sunglasses shall be professional in appearance, dark in color and removed when interacting with the public.

- A. ***Body Piercing:*** Visible body piercing, tongue, nose, face and ears, with the exception of stud earrings worn in the ear of female sworn officers, is prohibited.
- B. ***Tattoos:*** Visible tattoos are prohibited.
