Article 4

Shall the Town vote to raise and appropriate the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00) (gross budget) to purchase land and easements for conservation purposes, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to issue bonds or notes in compliance with provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA 33:1 et seq., as amended); provided, however, that notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Town shall not issue more than One Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) of bonds or notes in any one calendar year; to authorize the Selectmen to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof, and to take any other action they deem appropriate to effectuate the sale and/or issuance of said bonds or notes; and additionally to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for the bond's first year's interest payment and costs.
