

(WRITE-IN)

Shall the Pelham School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget yoled separately, the amounts set forth the bodge-posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session of the annual school district meeting, for the purposes set forth herein, totaling Thirty-Two Mil-lion, Three Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$32,387,970)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Thirty-One Million, Eight-Hundred Twelve Thousand, Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$31,812,068), which is the same as last regire Dollars (3-7,6-12,009), which is the same as a series as experience year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pelham School District or by law; or the Pelham School Board may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13 X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.
