Shall the Pelham School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Thirty-one million, Nine-hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$31,980,000) (gross budget) for the design, construction, furnishing and equipping of a major renovation and additions to the Pelham Memorial School and Its associated buildings and grounds facilities, with not more than Thirty-one million, Nine-hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$31,980,000) to be raised through the issuance of bonds or notes under and in compliance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA Chapter 33); to authorize the School Board to issue, negotiate, sell and deliver such bond and notes and determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof; to authorize the School Board to apply for, obtain, accept and expend federal, state or other alde which may be available for said project and to comply with all laws applicable to said project; to authorize the School Board to take any and all action necessary in connection therewith or to pass any other vote relative thereto, including but not limited to, the acquisition or conveyance of interests and real property necessary to complete the project; and further to raise and appropriate the additional sum of Seven hundred ninety-nine thousand, five hundred dollars (\$799,500) for the first year's payment of interest on the bond?
